

Online Planning Guide



The website gives Catholic families an opportunity to plan a Funeral Mass or Funeral Service using a step-by-step planning guide. The website has suggested readings, hymns and prayers that may be used.

## Making planning easy

The purpose of this website is to give Catholic families the opportunity to plan the contents of the Funeral Mass or Funeral Service with ease. The liturgy presented on this site is taken from the "Order of Christian Funerals with Cremation Rite" which has been approved for use and is the most widely used resource used by the Catholic Church in New Zealand. All bible readings on this site have been taken from the "Jerusalem Bible".

## Six easy steps

Planning the Funeral Mass for Funeral Service is completed with six easy steps. A range of readings, hymns and prayers are available from drop down menus and the words for these are also able to be viewed. It is very wise to make your choices in consultation with your local Catholic Priest, who will give you good ideas and suggestions as well.

- 1 Name the Celebrant or Priest who is to conduct the service. Choose the Processional Hymn or Music. Name the person who will deliver the Welcome and also the person who will read the Tribute or Eulogy.

- 2 Name who will do the First Reading and select the reading. Choose a Responsorial Psalm and who will read it or choose a Hymn or Music.

- 3 Name who will do the Second Reading and select the reading. At this stage you can choose a Gospel Acclamation if you have a choir. Choose a Gospel Reading which is read by the Celebrant.

- 4 Name who will read the Intercessions. Choose one or more Intercessions from those provided or you may choose to customise your own Intercessions.

- 5 This step is for those arranging a Funeral Mass. Name who will perform Presentation of Gifts. Choose Offertory Hymn or Music and also your Communion Hymn or Music.

- 6 Choose your Recessional Hymn or Music.

You then click **create planner** which will show all your choices on a summary page – you can make changes and then choose to print, save, or e-mail your summary page and the full version of your funeral planner.
